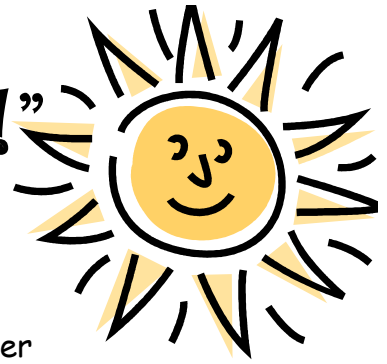


"Safe and Fun in the Sun!"

What: Poster or paper using any medium - markers, pencil, pen, paint, crayon.

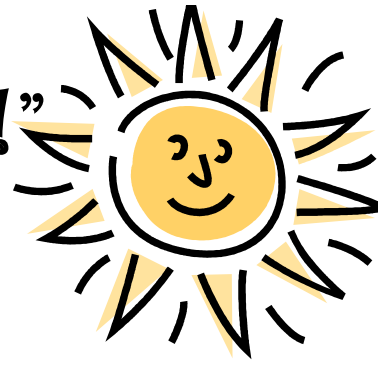
How: Make it creative, and try to use the words "Safe and Fun in the Sun." Be sure to submit an official entry form with your poster.

Key teaching points regarding sun exposure and skin cancer.

1. Skin cancer is common

- There are over 1,000,000 new cases of skin cancer every year in the United States.
- 1 in 5 Americans will develop skin cancer sometime during their lifetime.
- Not all forms of skin cancer are dangerous, but some types of skin cancer can be life-threatening.

2. Ultraviolet light from the sun causes skin cancer.

- Over 90% of all skin cancers are caused by the sun.
- When a person gets five sunburns, their risk of getting a skin cancer doubles.
- More sun exposure, including tanning and burning, means a greater risk of developing skin cancer.
- Ultraviolet light from tanning booths causes skin cancer just like the ultraviolet light from the sun.
- In addition to causing skin cancer, ultraviolet light wrinkles the skin and makes a person look older than they really are.

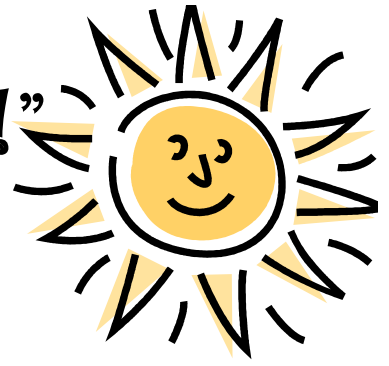
3. Skin Cancer can be prevented with good sun protection.

- Kids today who protect themselves from the sun can avoid getting skin cancer.
- Protecting yourself from the sun does not mean staying indoors - it means taking a few extra steps to make sure your skin is safe.
